

**Reactive To: Missouri Information Analysis Center**

On February 20, 09 The Missouri Information Analysis Center of Jefferson City MO issues an unclassified but law enforcement sensitive report that is as bogus and ill-conceived as the FBI Project Megiddo report that the FBI was forced to withdraw after my widespread reactive was published on the Internet. So that you understand the issue this report was issued under the name of the Governor of MO, Jeremiah Nixon, (who then after touting this to be a good report withdrew his support under immense pressure) MO State Highway Patrol, James F. Keathley colonel MSHP and Van Godsey as Director of MIAC who is the supposed author of the report. You are informed of this because this report is issued at the highest possible level of law and political enforcement in the State of Missouri with the approval of the governor of that state, which was followed by similar instrument by the Homeland Security Department. There can be no doubt as to the authorship of this report from the Southern Poverty Law Center, (SPLC) whose issuance of bogus information is widely known.

Not only are conclusions of this report stupid, they demonstrate an entire states police out of control and a governor who has obviously never read the constitution or is simply too stupid to understand it. The entire management of the State Police of Missouri who endorsed this report should be summarily fired. There is no place in a democratically managed state for people who share any of these opinions.

The very first statement of the report claims, "white males felt disenfranchised by female and minority empowerment in the 1960's and 70's", and that this combined with the loss of the Viet Nam war (1959-1975) "Spawned a paramilitary culture". How anyone could reach such a twisted conclusion is simply beyond the scope of this author. The further conclusions that Tom Clancy's novels, Solder of Fortune magazine, and Rambo movies were responsible for the militia movement are so ludicrous as to make criticism unnecessary. Furthermore the American militia movement did not gain size credence until the turn of the century.

At this point I want to make clear that the impetus for this report as many others of this type seems to emanate from the SPLC an organization with numerous government connections, government contracts, and is a money making machine for one Morris Dees about whom I am unable to make any kind favorable comments. Dees his SPLC and the JDL have been at the forefront of verbal attacks against anyone that they can use as a scapegoat for their extortive money raising schemes from their mostly unsophisticated Jewish contributors. The very next paragraph that now broadens the attack on the entire middle class who it claims are blaming their misfortunes on "The New World Order", the "United Nations" then claiming that the rhetoric is decidedly "anti-Semitic". This follows that Project Megiddo report that reached similar wrong conclusions.

Let us please face facts: The people are rightly angered by the finacial manipulations of the NY banksters and financiers and if these are not by majority Jews then pray tell us what they are! Furthermore there is absolutely no

connection between Americas' militia movement, banking and fiancé. Supplementary conclusions by Janet Napolitano secretary of HHS that veterans are part of this are uncalled for, stupid, ill informed and pointless, but then what can we possibly expect of someone of her ilk?

The report goes on to site the Ruby Ridge incident in which FBI snipers murdered in sequence Randy Weavers dog, his pre teen son by shooting him in the back and then his wife by shooting her in the head while she was holding Randy's youngest child. The FBI sniper was later promoted after state murder charges were suspended by the Fed. Randy Weaver was found innocent by a court of law! (1) Then came the Waco incident also only partially reported on. The fact that Janet Reno's department of justice violated the U.S. Constitution, Texas State laws, federal statutes, the Posse Comitatus Act, and in fact were directly responsible for the murder of 86 of which two were pregnant women 20 were children and 24 of which were British Subjects was omitted. (1) Then we are drawn into the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act of 1992 that the report claims spawned 850 militia groups (2) in the United States. (3)

We are now treated to a list of ten incidents, which are supposed to prove this reports validity. They do no such thing.

Item one: Took place in Alabama, lists an arrest but not a conviction, has nothing whatever to do with MO. (Source SPLC) In 1995

Item two: Took place in Reno Nevada, lists arrests but no convictions, has nothing whatever to do with MO. (Source SPLC) in 1995

Item three: Took place in Ohio, claims Aryan Republican Army shootout with an FBI agent. This organization, which is no more, operated in the early 90's, about 16 years ago. (Source SPLC) in 1996

Item four: 12 people arrested in (location missing) charged with conspiracy for looking at a government building, conviction not cited. In Jan 1996

Item five: This is the case of Eric Robert Rudolph a lone nut who was arrested for the Atlanta Olympic bomb act that took place in Atlanta GA July 1996, has absolutely nothing to do with MO

Item six: Seven members of the Mountaineer Militia, long disbanded were arrested and convicted of federal crimes, these acts took place in West Virginia and had nothing whatever to do with MO. (October 1996)

Item seven: bunch of nuts were arrested plotting to attack US military installations (location unreported) this conspiracy took place in 1997 o convictions reported)

Item eight: Members of the North American Militia were arrested on firearms charges in Michigan no conviction listed, has nothing whatever to do with MO (Source SPLC) in 1998

Item nine: Members of a California group were arrested and their leader was convicted plotting to kill a federal judge has nothing to do with MO took place in 1999 ten years ago.

Item ten: The leader (name not listed) was charged with conspiracy (conviction not listed) in December 1999 in FL and GA.

All this works out to about 48 arrests in 14 years or 3.5 arrests per year based on a population of 280 million at that time this enormous crime wave by

percentage was .000,000,8% or eight one hundred thousands of one percent per year of crime.

Please take note that not one of the listed causes bolstering this fallacious report is less than ten years old and that the first took place in 1995 fourteen years ago. The basis for police action in the state of Missouri is therefore founded upon information that is between ten and fourteen years old and none of which has anything at all to do with the state of Missouri, some of whose perpetrators were charged but not convicted.

The report then incorrectly reports that the militia movement declined after 1997. When it in fact grew at the turn of the century. It was after 2000 that the militia movement began to shrink which is acknowledged in the following paragraph.

We are now treated to eight incidents from 2000 to 2008; they just could not come up with more than eight in this eight-year time span. If you can only produce a list of eight crimes in eight years it could hardly be called a crime wave!

Not one of the cases lists any conviction. Some of the cases are heinous, however some indicate BATF and federal sting operations in which dumb people are induced to violate the law. All are over two years old not one of them occurred in Missouri. (All sourced from SPLC files)

It would be wise of the issuers of such reports federal as well as state to discount the SPLC entirely because, to the recollection of this author, they have not produced one worthwhile document in their entire history or that of Mr. Dees save perhaps the records of Mr. Dees first divorce, a review of which would shed much light onto SPLC as well as Mr. Dees. (4) A review of American history of the 20<sup>th</sup> century further reveals that over 87% of actions against America in espionage and violence have come from the political left and most commonly from zionists. Perhaps Mr. Dees is unable to recall the Rosenberg's, Morton Sobell and Alger Hiss.

The next paragraph is based on the personal opinion of the author and personal opinions do not belong in reports claiming to be factual. Conclusions including statement that right wing extremist groups are expanding due to assumed action by government are however right on the mark. With the unconstitutional Patriot Act, Homeland Security, and various statements made by president Obama as well as Eric Holder and Janet Napolitano, that should surprise no one. The following statement, "Newer versions of the New World Order conspiracy" Well excuse us all but is it not Geroge Herbert Walker Bush who told us about the new world order, and the thousand point s of light (5), didn't Mr. Brown the British PM also talk of it, and what about Messer W. Bush, J. Kerry, B. Clinton etc. The report speaks of anger against the government, i.e. congress and the executive, you bet, anger is a very mild word. Then there is anger against the FRS, well, how about that? They have reduced the value of a 1913-dollar to 0.02 cents in 96 years that works out to almost 100% inflation why should that anger anyone? If the morons in Washington DC and Montgomery (SPLC) and the various state capitols concentrated their efforts on government

for and by the people instead of re-election of themselves and making money, all this would evaporate.

Then we are informed of the **Ammunition Accountability Act**: Not only is this unworkable it would require an entire bureaucracy of thousands to keep track of this effort and it would not work. Anyone with the ability to light a fire can cast a lead bullet and anyone with an IQ over 85 can make ammunition and place a primer in the casing, this is simply another goofy left wing idea the authors of which know nothing about guns, shooting, or reloading. The reason the bill did not pass the Missouri legislature is because obviously the legislators understand the issue and the sponsors do not.

**Anticipation of the economic collapse of the US Government**, What this has to do with police, violence, and crime, remains unreported. Assumptions by the author are ludicrous at best and stupid to boot.
